Summary:

This staff report is intended to present the final draft array of projects for review and update of the annual Town of Steilacoom Six-year Transportation Improvement Plan. The public hearing on this topic is being held on the same date as part of the adoption process. Council may consider adoption (or amendment) of the proposed Plan as proposed.

Background:

All municipalities are required to update and file a copy of an adopted Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program with the Secretary of Transportation for the State of Washington, pursuant to RCW 35.77.010. This annual requirement also mandates a public participation process (public hearing) prior to consideration and adoption of the proposed Plan to provide the public an opportunity to express any opinions and provide feedback in this regard. A public hearing is being held on June 19, 2018 consistent with this requirement.

This document serves as a planning tool for regional, State and Federal transportation projects and programs and provides guidance to Town decision makers for funding opportunities and budgeting purposes as well.

Analysis:

Attached is the final draft priority listing for the next six years. A few highlights are noteworthy:

1. The 1st St. Project has been removed, as we anticipate completion of this project in the current year (2018).
2. The Steilacoom Blvd. Non-motorized Improvement Project was shifted up in priority, as this project reflects our next highest priority project and is anticipated to be constructed in the 1st year of the proposed Plan.
3. Several other locally planned projects have been shifted up to indicate higher priority ranking for possible completion in the future.
4. Two projects that recently received recommendations for funding through the Pierce County FHWA grant competition have been added to the plan to reflect

the recommended funding and proposed time for completion. These projects are:

- a. Rigney Rd. Non-motorized Improvements (construction in 2021)
- b. Rainier St. Preservation Project (construction in 2022)
5. The roundabout project at the intersection of Rainier St./Martin St. Union Ave. was shifted up in priority, reflecting progress toward potential funding of the improvements through a partnership with Pierce County. Staff continues to pursue alternative funding solutions to make this project possible.
6. Chambers St., Beech St. and Madrona Park Dr. (locally funded projects) were shifted down slightly in priority to facilitate the addition of the projects described in #4 above..

If the Council desires to make significant amendments to the proposed TIP, staff would resubmit the proposed TIP after additional changes are made and cost estimates can be determined.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends approval of the Six-Year Transportation Program as proposed.
