The Town of Steilacoom is considering changes to the Animal Control regulations in Chapter 8.08 in the Municipal Code, including a change to the language on the number of dogs and cats allowed at a dwelling unit. If that provision is adopted, a parallel regulation in the zoning ordinance, 18.16.040, will also require amendment. The Planning Commission must review all amendments to the zoning ordinance.

The proposed wording is: In residential zones, no more than a combined total of six ~~three (3)~~ dogs and/or cats, older than four (4) months of age, may ~~shall~~ be kept per dwelling unit.

Following public input, the Planning Commission will make its recommendation to the Town Council on this proposed ordinance.
